

## *The Varian - NACP grant*

Varian Medical Systems together with the Nordic Association for Clinical Physics (NACP) has re-established “The Varian – NACP grant”. The aim of the grant is to support a clinically working physicist in the field of radiation therapy and to encourage research and development in the field.

The grant of 3500 EUR will be awarded once per year to one Nordic physicist that has submitted the best motivation to why he/she should be awarded the grant. If the applicant wants to use the grant for travel to another hospital/clinic/institute, it has to be outside the USA.

Criteria for selecting the winner are: relevance of the study/project/collaboration, up-to-dateness, originality, and usefulness within the field. The evaluation will be performed by a board appointed by the NACP council. In case of equally assessed applications the board has the casting vote. In addition, the winner of the grant should be able to make a short presentation upon request, and a detailed description of what was accomplished with the grant must be sent to the NACP Secretary (including records of expenditures and receipts).

Applicants are invited to submit their forms for this Yearly grant before **March the 1<sup>st</sup>**.
