CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Dear Colleagues,

European Board for Accreditation in Medical Physics (EBAMP) is an independent body that accredits educational and training events in the field of Medical Physics (www.ebamp.eu). It is now counting four years of operation and it has successfully carried out more than 120 applications from all over Europe.

EBAMP is announcing elections for the renewal of its Board. The Board had nine (9) Members and is consisting from its President, Secretary General, Treasurer and five (5) Members. The 9th Member is the position of Past President. According to that, we are calling for nominations for:

- 1 position for President
- 1 position for Secretary General
- 1 position for Treasurer
- 5 positions for Member

All nominees are required to submit a CV to demonstrate that they meet the following criteria:

- a minimum of 10 years' experience in a senior position in medical physics, normally as an MPE
- a position which entails (or has in the past entailed) appraisal and management of the performance of individuals engaged in medical physics
- experience of teaching in medical physics at postgraduate level (EQF level 7 and/or 8)
- academic qualifications and experience in medical physics equivalent to EQF level 8 membership of a European NMO of EFOMP

Furthermore, all nominees are required also to submit:

- Letter of interest (for a particular position to the Board)
- The EB001 Declaration of Interest form (attached document)

Every nominee could apply for only one Board position. For more information concerning

the responsibilities of Board positions please read our Quality Manual, which is available at our web site.

The deadline for nominations is 30th of October 2020.
